Neighborhood Watch is a program of neighbors watching out for other neighbors during times when criminal activity would most likely occur, and reporting suspicious activity to police.

A police officer patrolling your neighborhood may not recognize a stranger in your yard - but your neighbors would. Neighbors know who you are and the type of car you drive. They may be the first to notice a burglar at your window or door - or a strange car in your driveway.

Protect Yourself By:

- Use good lighting.
- Lock your vehicles and don't leave valuables inside.
- Use good lock security,
- Install motion sensor lights.
- Keeping shrubs trimmed.
- Locking all doors and windows whenever your house is unoccupied.
- Letting a trusted neighbor know when you are on vacation. Don't advertise!! Stop deliveries and have all mail picked up.
